Introduction:

This document provides general information about using Apple Remote Access 3.0 with Global Village Macintosh products.

Apple's ARA 3.0 software can work with your Global Village product in many ways. However, there are some functionality differences in how you can use ARA 3.0 versus using earlier versions, such as 2.1.

Fax/ARA Call Sensing

Because of the programming/coding differences in ARA 3.0, Fax/ARA Call Sensing capabilities will no longer work. The following modems that support Fax/ARA Call Sensing will work with ARA 2.1 or earlier:

- TelePort Platinum
- TelePort 33.6 Internet Edition
- TelePort 33.6 Speakerphone Edition

If your modem is not listed above, it does not support Fax/ARA Call Sensing with any version of ARA.

ARA 3.0 Scripts

Apple has provided all necessary scripts for Global Village Macintosh modems that are needed to use ARA 3.0.

OneWorld Server

ARA 3.0 will work in every way that ARA 2.1 does. New features that come with ARA 3.0 are not supported with the OneWorld for functions such as TCP/IP address routing or PPP dial in. Currently, we have no information regarding any plans to upgrade the OneWorld for IP address routing. However, this feature should be addressed in the next generation of OneWorld Server product, currently in development.
