



How to... Install ARA Scripts for Global Village Modems

Introduction:

This document provides information about how to install modem scripts for Apple Remote Access (ARA) Software. For instructions on how to use ARA, please contact Apple.

Depending on the version of ARA and Apple OS installed on your computer, some GlobalFax installers will install either an ARA 2.0.x or ARA 2.1/3.0 script in your System Folder.

The installer may also place scripts for either ARA 2.0.x or ARA 2.1/3.0 in the ARA folder of your Global Village software. This folder is found within a folder called "Scripts." If you have difficulties locating this folder, follow the steps below.

1. From the Finder, choose Find from File menu (Command-F), type in **Scripts** and click **OK**. This should find a few items with the word "scripts" in the file names.
2. Find the folder named **Scripts** that is located in a Global Village related folder, and double-click on its icon. Inside should be the ARA folder.

If you install ARA software or download a new ARA script after you install your Global Village software, you must copy the appropriate ARA script to your System Folder.

ARA 2.0.x users: Drag the Apple Remote Access 2.0 script for your modem to the **Extensions** folder, in your **System Folder**.

ARA 2.1/3.0 users: Drag the ARA 2.1/3.0/OT-PPP script for your modem to the **Modem Scripts** folder, in the **Extensions** folder, in your **System Folder**.
